




Christian Ehresman Farm (#6)

Beginning at the northeast corner of the yard marked by a corner fence post and denoted as Point A, go south 150 feet along the yard line to the southwest corner of the yard, denoted as Point E. Turn at a 90° angle, travel 75 feet west along the cultivated field until you reach Woodsdale Road. Turn at a 90° angle and travel 150 feet north along Woodsdale Road until you reach the northwest corner of the yard, denoted as Point D. Turn at a 90° angle and travel east 75 feet along the yard line until you reach Point A.

Approximately one acre.




